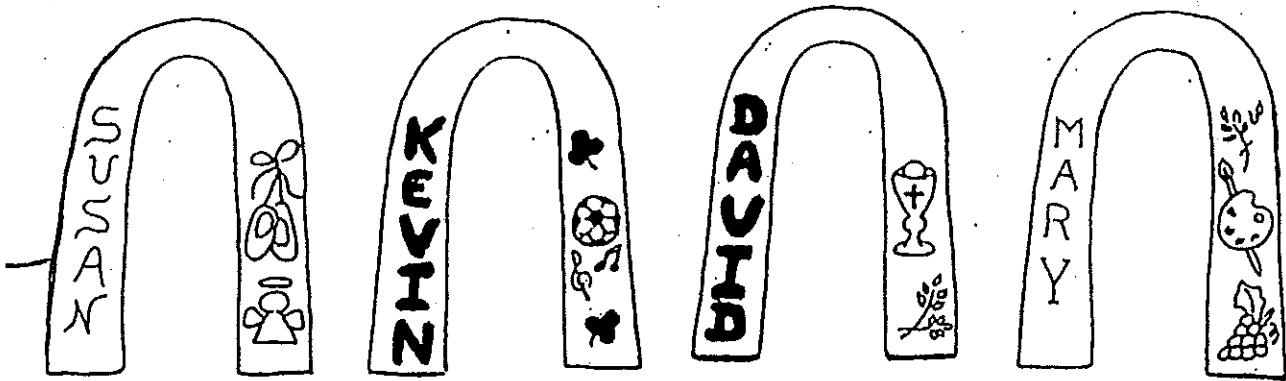

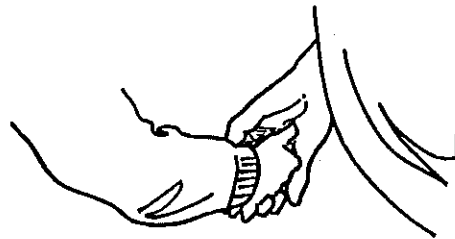
RECONCILIATION ROBES

Parent and Child Project

The robes will be worn at the Celebration of First Reconciliation. It is important that each child has his/her own robe for this special occasion.

Directions:

1. On the lower right hand side, print the child's name. You may use fabric paint, marker, glitter, felt or any material you wish.
2. On the left hand side, you may place any symbol to reflect your child's interests and/or uniqueness (ie: soccer ball, ballet shoes, cross, shamrock, etc.). This may also be done with fabric paint, glitter, material, etc.
3. Bring the completed robe to Church with you on the day assigned for your child to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
4. After your child has received the Sacrament of Reconciliation place the robe around him/her. Take your child to the exit, receive the ring, and place it on his or her finger.
5. Please plan on joining us in Upper Kolbe Hall for refreshments.

FAMILY BANNER FOR FIRST COMMUNION CELEBRATION

Have your child design from pieces of felt or markers a picture that represents his/her understanding of Eucharist or something special learned this year. (Could be a heart, Chalice/Host, sun, happy face, etc.) *Be creative!*

It should be the child's idea, but parental guidance is encouraged with the actual making of the banner.

The banners will be hung on the family pew during the First Communion Liturgy and hopefully can be kept as a treasured possession by your child.

Try to keep the lettering to a minimum. The following phrases might give you some ideas:

God is always with us.

Jesus loves me.

I love Jesus.

Directions:

The fabric for the banner can be felt or any material of your choice. The dimensions should be approximately 12" x 18" with a 14" dowel and 20" length of cord. Your child's NAME should be on the back of the banner. Cut out pieces of felt or use markers to make the design. The felt is available at any fabric store or 5&10 at minimal cost and can be glued with Elmers type glue.
